

Grand Junction Colorado

March 14th. A. D. 1893

City Council met in Regular session. Mayor L. M. Miller being absent. President of the City Council. D. P. Stelberger presided as chairman. Aldermen present were J. E. Hall, A. J. Mc Cune, A. R. Wadsworth, A. N. Anderson and J. T. Shuck

Minutes of meetings held February 17th, 21st & 28th were read and approved. J. F. Byres (Chief of Fire Department) made his report as per order of City Council, which on motion was accepted and adopted. Reports of City Treasurer, City Marshal and Police Magistrate, for month of February were read and referred to the Finance Com. Committee on Streets & Alleys through its chairman Mr Wadsworth reported adversely to the proposition of D. R. Harlow to sprinkle the streets. On motion the report of the Com. was adopted.

Mr Wadsworth also reported and recommended the purchase of one street leveler from Oscar Walker for \$12.50

The warrant to be given in exchange for Express & Job Wagon Licenses. On motion the report was adopted. A petition signed by W. A. Jamblin et al. asking that a side-walk be laid from Mr. Skimmers place running across the R. P. be built, the petition was referred to the Com. on Streets & Alleys

An ordinance relative to the Salaries of City Officers was read and adopted by the following vote. (The rules having been suspended) J. S. Hall yeas D. P. Stetzelberger yeas A. J. Mc. Cune yeas A. R. Wadsworth yeas A. N. Anderson yeas J. S. Shash yeas

Whereas in the opinion of a two-thirds majority of the City Council it is necessary that a new side-walk be constructed along and in front of the following described lots and blocks to-wit: On the South side and in front of lots 17 to 32 inclusive in block 124.

On the North and in front of lots 1 to 16 inclusive in Block 141. On the West and in front of lots 11, 12, & 13 in Block 39

Therefore be it ordered that a side-walk such as described by ordinance save and excep that it shall be four (4) feet wide instead of twelve (12) feet wide and laid upon three stringers be constructed upon the South and in front of lots 17 to 32 inclusive in Block 124. On the North and in front of lots 1 to 16 inclusive in Block 141. and on the West and in front of lots 11, 12, 13 in block 39 all of said side-walks to be constructed under the provisions of the ordinance concerning Side-walks

The following places were designated for the voting places in the different wards at the coming City Election to be held April 4th 1893

- 1st Ward. Lee Purnell's house corner 2nd & Colorado Ave.
- 2nd Ward Traveling mens Sample room at rear of Brunswick Hotel
- 3rd Ward Old Rink Building on Main Street
- 4th Ward Albion Dining Room on Main St.
