City Council met pursuant to adjournment

Reported that they had examined the reports of the City Treasurer
City Marshal & Police Magistrate for month of February and
found same correct. On motion the report of the committee
was accepted and adopted. Reports of City Treasurer, City

Marshal and Police Magistrate for month of March was read
and referred to the Finance Com. A Petition from the Representatives
of the Press, asking for better accommodations at City Council Room
was read and on motion referred to the Finance Committee

The Bond of Fred W. Cobb and Joseph C. Dulmair for Saloon
License was read and on motion approved

A. R. Wadsworth Chairman of Com. on Streets & Alleys
reported upon the Petition of the residence of the Crawford addition
for sidewalk, that the City owned no land for a street or alley
across the railway, and therefore it was impossible to build and sidewalk
to said addition. On motion the report of the committee was
adopted.

The Finance committee was on motion empowered to obtain the Treasurers annual report and examine his books and report at next meeting of the City Council. The City Marshal was on motion ordered to notify certain owners of cesspools to have them cleaned and disinfected at once.
