

Grand Junction Colorado

April 17th A. D. 1893

City Council met pursuant to adjournment. Present Mayor L. M. Miller. Aldermen A. J. Mc Cune, J. J. Shoup, B. C. Smith, A. R. Wadsworth, J. S. Hall. Minutes of meeting of City Council held April 11th A. D. 1893 read and approved. Mayor elect. M. L. Allison, and Aldermen elect. W. S. Wallace, W. S. Wallace, James H. Corgrove, M. J. Devereux and John J. McQuillian, took their oaths of office respectively. On motion City Council adjourned.

Mayor M. L. Allison called the Council to order. The roll being called, the following aldermen were present to wit: J. S. Hall, A. J. Mc Cune, A. R. Wadsworth, W. S. Wallace, James H. Corgrove, M. J. Devereux and J. J. McQuillian. Mayor M. L. Allison <sup>read</sup> a proclamation setting forth his views. Applications for office were read and on motion a committee of three on order of business were appointed consisting of A. J. Mc Cune, M. J. Devereux and A. R. Wadsworth who recommended the election of City officers in the following order: City Marshal, Policeman, Street Com, Police Magistrate, City Clerk, City Attorney and City Surveyor. On motion the report of the committee was adopted.
