May 1<sup>st</sup> A. D. 1893

City Council met in special session at the call of the Mayor. Present Mayor M. L. Allison. Aldermen J. S. Hall. A. G. W. Cune. A. B. Wadsworth. W<sup>m</sup> Campbell W. S. Walker James. H. Cosgrove and M. J. Derieux

Mayor M. L. Allison stated that the meeting had been called for the purpose of appointing a City Physician. Alderman J. S. Hall moved that the City Council employ a city Physician to hold his office at the pleasure of the City Council, at a salary of \$50.00 per month motion carried. On motion of Alderman M. J. Derieux Dr. Ingorsoll, was unanimously elected City Physician

On motion of Alderman Wadsworth The City Physician was instructed to quarantine all houses, where contagious diseases were known to exist and the City Marshal instructed to cooperate with the City Physician and if necessary arrest any person who violates the instructions of the City Physician relative to Quarantine

On motion City Council adjourned
