

Grand Junction Colorado.

June 13th A.D. 1893

City Council met in regular session. Present. Mayor M. G. Allison. Aldermen A. R. Wadsworth, J. S. Hall, J. H. Cargrove, W. S. Wallare, M. J. Devereux, J. J. McQuilliam and Wm Campbell. Minutes of regular session held May 9th and minutes of special meeting May 16th read and approved.

W. A. Kird appeared before the City Council and asked that a certain fine of \$5.⁰⁰ imposed on him for the violation of certain Quarentine rules, be suspended. On motion his request was so granted.

Reports of City Treasurer, City Marshal and Police Magistrate for month of May was read and referred to the Finance Com. Report of Street Commissioner was read and referred to the Com. on Streets and Alleys. Report of City Engineer as to supply of Mountain water for the City of Grand Junction, was read and on motion accepted, and ordered filed, and the committee on water continued to make further investigation, and to develop the springs on Pinon Mesa, at an expense of not to exceed \$300.⁰⁰

In support of the above resolution motion, the following resolution was read. Be it resolved by the mayor & city Council of the City of Grand Junction Colo. in regular session convened. That the sum of \$300.⁰⁰ be and the same is hereby appropriated and set apart from the General Fund of said City for the purpose of defraying the expenses of further prospecting for mountain water to be used for domestic purposes in and for the said City of Grand Junction, The above resolution was adopted by the following vote A. R. Wadsworth yeas, J. S. Hall yeas, J. H. Cargrove yeas, W. S. Wallare yeas, M. J. Devereux yeas, J. J. McQuilliam yeas & Wm Campbell yeas.

M. J. Devereux of the com. on Licenses, reported that it was their opinion that the ordinance relative to saloon license be enforced, and that no licenses be reduced. On motion the report was adopted. A. R. Wadsworth reported adversely to the removal of the Water box on Main St. between 57 & 61st St. On motion the report was adopted.

Finance Com. through Alderman Hall reported that they had examined the reports of the City Treasurer, City Marshal and Police Magistrate for month of April and found same correct; on motion the report was accepted and adopted.

A. R. Wadsworth reported that they had purchased a street sprinkler and were expecting it - daily. On motion the report was adopted.

entire subject of Street Sprinkling was referred to the Com. on Streets & Alleys with power to act. Alderman

W. S. Wallare, as chairman of the Com. on Fire and Water reported that they had purchased uniforms for the Firemen. On motion the report was adopted.

a communication from the "San Juan Silver Chatterbox" at Ouray, was read, inviting the Grand Junction City Council to attend there the 4th of July. On motion the City Clerk was instructed to make proper reply to the invitation.

The report of the City Wager for month of May was read and referred to the Finance Com. The report of the City Physician for Month of May was read and passed without action. At this time A. R. Wadsworth tendered his resignation as Alderman from the 1st Ward which on motion was accepted.

Mr Boyer appeared before the Council and asked permission to erect a certain kind of building on Colorado Ave., not in accordance with the requirement of the City ordinance, relative to buildings within the City ^{fire} limits. on motion the request was not granted.

The following bills were read and allowed and the Clerk instructed to draw warrants for the same.
