

Grand Junction Colorado

July 11th 1893

City Council met in regular session. Present. Mayor M. D. Allison, Aldermen J. S. Hall, A. J. McKune, W. H. Campbell, J. H. Colgrove, W. S. Wallace, M. J. Devereux and J. J. McQuillan. Minutes of regular meeting held June 13th and minutes of special meetings held June 27th and July 1st A. D. 1893 read and approved. Petition for sidewalk signed by Kimmringhoff, Skinner et al. read and referred to committee on Streets & Alleys.

Monthly reports of City Treasurer, City Marshal, Police Magistrate and City Engineer for June were read and referred to the Finance Committee. Report of Chief of Fire Department and of the City Clerk were read and approved. Report of Street Com. on work done on City Park was read and referred to Com. on Streets & Alleys.

Finance com. reported that they had examined the reports of City Treasurer, City Marshal, Police Magistrate and City Engineer for month of May and found same correct. On motion the report of the Finance Com. was accepted & adopted.

Com. on Streets & Alleys to whom had been referred the subject of street sprinkling with power to act. Reported that they had purchased and paid for a street sprinkler. Contracted with Mr. Fish to run the street sprinkler for \$80.⁰⁰ per month and contracted with the water Com. for water for street sprinkling at \$35⁰⁰ per month. That Mr. Fish had not yet signed the contract. On motion the report was adopted.

Mayor Allison reported that all work relative to securing mountain water for the City had been suspended for the present.

Alderman Wallace introduced the following Resolution - Resolved - That a committee of three be appointed by the chair, to be known as the auditing Com. That it shall be the duty of this Com. to audit all bills not referred to some of the standing committees; and to contract for and purchase all supplies for the City. And no bill shall be allowed unless so audited, and no officer or other person shall be authorized to contract any liabilities or make any purchase for the city; without first having been authorized so to do by a majority of the com. On motion the resolution was adopted. The following Com. was appointed auditing Com. W. S. Wallace, A. J. McKune & M. J. Devereux.

Alderman Hall, introduced the following Resolution - Be it Resolved - By the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, That the \$1109.⁰² surplus in the Water fund of the City Treasury, be and the same is hereby ordered loaned and transferred from the said water fund to the General fund of said City, to be temporarily used for paying the current expenses of the City Government; and the City is hereby ordered to make said transfer, of said fund, from said water fund of the City, and to use the same in paying the current expenses as hereinbefore designated. On motion the resolution was adopted.

The following bills were read and on motion allowed and the clerk instructed to draw warrants for the same.
