October 2<sup>nd</sup> A.D. 1893

City Council met at call of the Mayor. Present: Mayor M. L. Allison. Aldermen J. E. Hall. A. J. McCune. W. Campbell J. H. Corgrove. W. S. Wallare. M. J. Deveraux. J. J. McMillan

The finance committee introduced the following resolution Be it resolved, That for the purpose of defraying the expenses and liabilities, of the City of Grand Junction for the fiscal year beginning April 1<sup>st</sup> 1893 and ending March 31<sup>st</sup> 1894, there be levied and collected on all taxable property, real and personal within the limits of the said City, the following tax on each dollar of valuation of such property to-wit: For all purposes eleven mills on the dollar of such valuation. The above resolution was adopted by the following vote: J. E. Hall yeas. A. J. McCune yeas W. Campbell yeas. J. H. Corgrove yeas. W. S. Wallare yeas. M. J. Deveraux yeas and J. J. McMillan yeas

W. S. Wallare. introduced the following resolution to-wit Be it Resolved, That in view of the present financial condition of the community, that the present saloon license as now collected works a hardship upon the persons engaged in that business, and that it is therefore the sense of this body, that the license for the next six months shall be collected monthly, and the City Treasurer is hereby instructed to issue his duplicate receipts for \$835 dollars each month, to parties now holding saloon privileges; and the City Clerk shall issue a license when the total amount of the receipts, filed in his office, equal the total amount of the license fee due from such party. Upon a yeas & Nays vote the above resolution was unanimously adopted.
