

# Grand Junction Colorado

Dec. 12th A. D. 1843

City Council met in regular session. Present Mayor, M. L. Allison, Aldermen J. G. Hall, Wm. Campbell, J. H. Cosgrove, M. J. Devereux and J. J. McQuillan. Mayor Allison having to go away on business. On motion M. J. Devereux was elected Chairman.

Minutes of regular meeting of the City Council held Nov. 14 1843 were read and approved. Reports of City Treasurer, City Marshal, Police Magistrate, and City Wayer for month of Nov. were read and referred to Finance com.

Finance com. reported that they had examined the reports of the City Treasurer, City Marshal, Police Magistrate for and City Wayer for month of October and found same correct. On motion the report of the Finance Com. was adopted.

A petition for side-walk to Crawford addition. was read and on motion referred to the com. on Streets & Alleys to report at next meeting of the city council.

W. A. Marsh from the School Board of Grand Junction. appeared before the city council and asked that the City council take the necessary steps to keep the boys off of the streets after certain hours at night.

On motion the matter was referred to the City Attorney to report at the next meeting of the City Council

City Marshal was instructed to arrest all persons who had not paid their city licenses. The following bills were read and allowed and on motion the Clerk was instructed to draw warrants for the same.
