Devereux no, J. J. McQuillian yea. City Treasurer's report for month of December was presented and referred to Finance Com. Bill of Dr. L. F. Ingrossell for \$50⁰⁰ was on motion referred to the Board of Health. Bill of Gen. C. Haskell for \$10⁰⁰ was on motion referred to the purchasing com.

On motion the Prostitutes were ordered prosecuted as formerly. On motion Saloon license was reduced to \$50⁰⁰ per month to take effect Jan. 1st 1894.
