February 13th A. D. 1894

City Council met in regular session. Present. Mayor M. L. Allison. Aldermen. J. S. Hall. A. J. W. Cune W. S. Wallare. J. H. Cosgrove. M. J. Devereux and J. J. W. Milliam. Minutes of regular meeting held January 9th and of special meeting held January 17th A. D. 1894 read and approved.

A communication from W. P. Clark and Chas. K. William was read wherein they accepted all the terms and specifications of the ordinance passed by the City Council relative to their Telephone franchise. On motion the communication was ordered filed. City Marshal City Wager and Police Magistrate for month for January were read and referred to Finance com. Also the reports of the street Com. and City Clerk were referred to the Finance com. Finance com. reported that they had examined the reports of the City Treasurer. City Wager. City Marshal and Police Magistrate for month of December and found same correct. On motion the report was adopted.

A bill from the Daily Star Times was on motion referred to the Finance com. with power to act. Bill of W. S. Hammond for \$17⁰⁰ for coal was referred to the Purchasing com. All bills from the Police court and the Grand Junction Water Co. were referred to the Finance Com.
