March 13th A. D. 1894

City Council met pursuant to adjourned. Present Mayor M. L. Allison. Aldermen A. J. McCune. Wm. Campbell. J. H. Corgrove M. J. Devereux and J. J. McQuilliam. Minutes of Special meeting held Feb. 27th 1894 and of regular meeting held March 13th at 9 o'clock A. M. 1894 read and approved. Reports of City Wayer City Marshal. City Treasurer were read and referred to the Finance Com. Finance com. reported that they had examined the reports of all the city officers for month of January and found same correct. on motion the report of the Finance com. was adopted. Finance com. further reported and recommended that all bills from the Police court be not allowed. on motion the report was adopted. By unanimous vote the City Clerk was instructed that at the ensuing
 general city election to be held in Grand Junction Colo. April 3rd 1894 to
 submit to the voters of said city the proposition to ~~be~~ \$2500⁰⁰ sewerage
 bonds, ^{and that all material to be used in the construction of the same be manufactured here,} cash being the amount payable to the Grand River
 ditch company for 100 statute inches of water, for the city of Grand Junction
 for the year beginning May 10th 1894. The city clerk was instructed
 by unanimous vote to draw a warrant on the General fund in
 favor of A. J. Mc Cune sufficient to cover said amount.
