

Grand Junction, Colorado, August 14/94

Council met in regular session, Hon W.L. Allison Mayor presiding. Present Aldermen, Wallace, Cosgrove, ~~McQuillen~~ McCary, Pratt, Gannon, Devereux

Minutes of July 12th regular meeting were read and on motion approved

The petition of Lorin A. Staley and others, was read, and on motion, the marshal was instructed to enforce the ordinance regarding license on dogs

The petition of the Fire Department asking for an appropriation of \$500 for Peder Day was read, and on motion the Clerk was instructed to transfer from general fund to fire department fund, say an amount sufficient after paying all bills now presented, to make the fund \$400 and to draw a warrant to the order of the Committee for the sum of \$400, Wallace, Cosgrove, McCary, Pratt Gannon, voting yea, Devereux voting no.

Reports of the city treasurer, marshal, police magistrats city weigher for July were read and referred to finance ^{Committee} On motion, it was resolved that the attention of the Fire Chief be called to his duties regarding tests of fire plugs and that he be requested to report thereon at the next regular meeting

On motion the bill of Daniel Wheeler for \$60¹⁴ was allowed, and the Clerk instructed to draw a warrant for same sufficient to pay it in cash, Wallace, Cosgrove McCary, Gannon voting yea, Pratt and Devereux voting no

On motion it was ordered that the sidewalks on main Street between the Board of Trade saloon and 5th St and ^{west side} on 5th St between main St and alley be repaired under supervision of Street Commissioners

On motion the bills were allowed and the Clerk instructed to draw warrants for the same, all present voting yea.

On motion bills of Lee & Bunting \$6⁵⁰ and the Grand Junction Water Company 50⁴ were referred to purchasing committee for their report.

On motion bills of W. & Lee for 2⁰⁰ and Willis Smith Co for \$3⁵⁰ were allowed and the Clerk instructed to draw warrants for the same, Wallace, Cosgrove, McCary, Gammon Devereux voting yea, Pratt voting no.

On motion, it was resolved that the Clerk be instructed to draw a warrant to the order of N. J. Krusen Treasurer of Peach Day Committee for the sum of \$1000⁰⁰

On motion, the Mayor was requested to appoint a committee of 3 members of council, to audit Peach Day appropriation, himself to be a member thereof, to see that the appropriation is properly expended pro rata with the county appropriation

The Mayor appointed to act with him, Messrs Gammon and Pratt

On motion the Clerk was instructed to send formal invitations to city governments of Colorado to visit Grand Junction, on Peach Day Sept 11th AD 1894

On motion council adjourned
