

Grand Junction, Colo, Sept 19, 1894

In pursuance to a call for a special meeting of the city council, signed by W. S. Wallace Pres. pro tem., Mc O. Delaplain John L. Pratt and C. P. McCary, city council met in special session, W. S. Wallace President presiding, present John L. Pratt, C. P. McCary, E. W. Gannon, J. J. McQuillan, Mr

Deveraux <sup>minutes of meeting of August 14, 1894 were read and on motion approved</sup>  
The Finance Committee by W. S. Wallace Chairman reported that they had examined the reports of the city officers including the Janitor for the months of May June and July and found them correct. On motion the report was accepted

On motion they were allowed and the Clerk instructed to draw warrants for the same, <sup>all present voting yea.</sup>

Applications of James Commis for pay for services as special policeman for five days, Thomas Price 2 1/2 days, David Hanna one day Edward Bliss two days were then presented and read.

On motion the compensation for special policeman was fixed at \$2<sup>50</sup> per day and the Clerk was instructed to file in amounts in bills presented and draw warrants for same all present voting yea.

The bills of Star Times Publishing Company \$2.75, Lee Printing \$15<sup>25</sup>, Jos. P. Sweeney 35¢ were read and referred to Purchasing Committee for report.

An ordinance to amend section 2 of an ordinance entitled "An ordinance to authorize the erection, construction and operation of a system of water works in the town of Grand Junction etc" was presented and read and on motion referred to a special committee to be appointed by the President who thereupon appointed as such committee, Aldermen Pratt, Deveraux and Gannon for their report at next regular meeting.

The resignation of M. O. Delaplain as alderman from the 1<sup>st</sup> ward presented and on motion accepted

The council then proceed to fill vacancy occasioned by resignation of M. O. Delaplain  
C. E. Jenkins and P. J. Supp were placed in nomination and council proceeded to ballot for choice

Ballots being read showed that Jenkins received 4 votes  
Supp 2 votes

On motion, the election of C. E. Jenkins as alderman from 1<sup>st</sup> ward was made unanimous, all present voting yea.

On motion council adjourned
