

Grand Junction Colo Oct 9, 1894

The city council met in regular session, Hon Mr. Allison Mayor presiding, present Aldermen Wallace, Pratt, Jenkins, Gannon, McQuellian and Cosgrove

Minutes of meetings of September 19th and October 4th were read and on motion approved Reports of City Marshal, Janitor, Police Magistrate and City Treasurer for September read and referred to the Finance Committee

The special committee on water works, ^{ordinance} by J. L. Pratt reported that it had examined the proposed ordinance and found it to agree with the contract previously made with the Water Company and reported it back without recommendations

On motion, the ordinance as presented was not approved and was rejected, Wallace, Pratt, Jenkins, Gannon, McQuellian Cosgrove voting yea.

On motion, former committee appointed to confer with the water works company was discharged

On motion it was ordered that a committee of three, the Mayor to be chairman, be appointed to get the price of the water company and to formulate a proposition to be submitted to the voters of Grand Junction, looking to the putting in of a system of water works and to report at the next regular meeting of the council, at which time, if the report is satisfactory, a special election shall be called to submit the question of the issue of bonds to the people

The Mayor appointed as members of the committee, Messrs Wallace and Cosgrove

On motion the petition of George Ryan to erect a ^{conspicuous sign} ~~porch~~ addition to his house on Lot 10 Block 103 was allowed

On motion, the frame steps to upper story of building at N.E. Cor 4th Main were allowed to be finished

The claim of Mrs Westlake for damage to her building on Colo. Ave was referred to the City Attorney for opinion
