

Grand Junction, Colo. March 26, 1895

Council met pursuant to adjournment, Hon. M. L. Allison Mayor presiding, present Aldermen Wallace, McCary, Gannon Cosgrove, McQuillin, Crawford, Pratt

An motion the official bond of Lorin A. Staley, as City Attorney was approved

On motion, bills of Pearl Knowles for \$75 and C. L. Carson for \$31⁵⁰ were allowed, and the Clerk instructed to draw warrants for them, Wallace, McCary, Gannon, Cosgrove, McQuillin, Crawford, Pratt voting yes.

The Street & Alley Committee reported recommending that the sidewalk petition of C. S. Larson and others be granted, and on motion the report was adopted, petition granted, and sidewalk ordered to be built 6 feet wide, all present voting yes.

On motion, the rules were suspended and it was unanimously decided to consider the ordinances making annual appropriation, and fixing salaries

An ordinance concerning salaries and fees of City Attorney, Mayor and Aldermen, was offered and read by Mr. Wallace and on motion was passed and adopted, Wallace, McCary, Cosgrove, Pratt voting yes, Gannon, McQuillin, Crawford voting no.

The annual appropriation bill for the fiscal year, beginning April 1st 1895 and ending March 31st 1896 was read, and offered and it was moved that it be passed as read.

An amendment was offered that the street and alley fund be increased \$5000, to a total amount of \$6000 for the purpose of opening up Main Street, and on vote, the amendment carried McCary, Cosgrove, McQuillin, Crawford, voting yes, Wallace, Gannon, Pratt, voting no.

On the original motion, McCary, Cosgrove, McQuillin, Crawford Wallace, Gannon, Pratt voted yes and it was declared carried

An ordinance entitled "An ordinance concerning the riding of Bicycles, Tricycles, Velocipedes and other similar vehicles" was read and offered by Mr. McCary.

The matter of constructing the crossing of Main Street over the Rd. crossing, was on motion referred to City Attorney and Street Committee with instructions to take up the matter with proper authorities

In the matter of constructing the syphon into the Crawford Subdr. on motion the Mayor was instructed to appoint a committee of 3 with power to construct the syphon

The Mayor appointed as said committee Pratt, Gannon, McCary

On motion Council adjourned
