

Grand Junction Colo. April 12, 1895
Council met pursuant to adjournment, Hon. W. L. Allison, Mayor in the Chair;
On motion of Alderman Cosgrove, seconded by McCoy, in the absence of the
City Clerk, D. F. McAuley was made Clerk Pro. Tem.

On calling the Roll the following Aldermen responded: Messrs Cosgrove
Crawford, McCoy, McQuillan & Wallace. Absent: Messrs. Drevieux, Gannon & Pratt

The minutes of the meetings of April 9 were read. Alderman Wallace
called attention to the claim of the G. V. Irrigation Co; as allowed it was
payable in Cash. The Council concurred in this statement. There being
no objection the Chair declared the minutes stood approved

Reports

Alderman Wallace Chairman Finance Committee, to whom had been referred
the monthly reports of the various officers and the annual reports of the
City Clerk and Treasurer made a verbal report: stating that owing to
the absence from the City of the other members of the Committee, no meetings
had been held. So far as examined by him personally, he had found the
various reports correct; had not checked up with County Treasurer, and advised
that the work be completed before any action on the part of the Council

The Chair appointed Alderman McQuillan a member of the Finance
Committee, during the absence from the City of Alderman Drevieux.

On motion of Alderman Cosgrove, seconded by Alderman McCoy, the report
of the Chairman Committee on Finance was accepted and referred back to
Committee, to report at next Monday morning's meeting of the Council
