

Grand Junction Colo May 21st 1895

Adjourned meeting of the City Council was held this evening.

Hon. Mr. Allison Mayor. presiding. Present Aldermen Pratt, Lee, McCary, Barton, Dean, Coleman, Wharton.

Sy. McMullin City Clerk was excused.
 Jos. P. Sweney appointed clerk pro term.

Mrs. Julien asked permission to build a frame house in the fire limits. After a discussion on the matter

Alderman Coleman moved. That Mrs. Julien be allowed to erect a frame house, said house to have a tin roof.

 Motion lost.

Mr. Kippie appeared before the council and requested that the small brick building east of his store on main street be condemned as it endangered his property. After considerable discussion the matter was referred to the Committee on fire & police with instructions to ~~notify the owners to remove the building.~~ ^{investigate & report}

Alderman Dean spoke regarding an improvement in the fire alarm system and made some suggestions in regards to it.

On motion. That a committee of two of the council and the City Atty. be appointed to examine the books and report of the City Clerk.
 RO ordered

The Mayor appointed Aldermen Coleman and Free
as committee.
