Grand Junction, Tuesday Evng. June 10, 1895

Informal

In the absence of the Mayor and President Pro. Tem. Alderman Coleman nominated Ald Lee for Chairman Pro. Tem.

Moved by Ald Dean & seconded by Ald Wharton that Ald Lee be elected Chairman Pro. Tem. The motion prevailed there being not a dissenting voice.

D. F. McCauley read a communication from the City Clerk delegating D. F. McCauley to represent him at this regular meeting.

On motion D. F. McCauley was elected Clerk Pro. Tem. by viva voce vote.

The Chair directed the Calling of the Roll.
