Adjourned Session of Council

Grand Junction June 26, 1895
A special meeting of the Council was held in Council Chamber at 8 P.M.
His Honor Mayor Nelson in the Chair

Present Aldermen Barton, Coleman, Dean, Pratt & Wharton. Absent Aldermen Cannon,

The official bonds of F. W. Cobb, City Clerk Elect and Geo. R. Barton, Fire Chief
were presented and read

The official bond of the City Clerk had for signatures: Fred W. Cobb, James W.
Buellin, Benton Cannon & B. J. Smyer. The City attorney stated he had examined the
bonds of City Clerk & Fire Chief and they were properly drawn

On motion of Ald Barton, the bond of F. W. Cobb was accepted and approved
viva voce vote

The bond of the Fire Chief had for signatures: Geo. R. Barton, C. P. Noland and
W. N. Lee

On motion the bond of the Fire Chief was accepted and approved, viva voce
Ald Barton Chairman Fire & Police Dep. submitted the following report in regard to
petition of Dr. L. F. Ingessard:

The undersigned Com. Fire & Police do hereby recommend that Dr. L. F. Ingessard be
permitted to erect a coal house not to exceed the following dimensions 6' x 8' +
and 6 feet high, the same to be erected on lot 6 Block 103, and to be not less
than 20 feet from dwelling house, and to be covered with corrugated iron sides & top

be, and the same is hereby reliefsed and it is hereby ordered that said firm
be retained as Assistant Council in said cases and it is further ordered that a
retainer fee of \$700⁰⁰ be paid said firm, and the Clerk instructed to draw a
warrant in their favor for said amount.
