

Grand Junction, Colorado. September 10th 1895.

Council met in regular session. Mayor Allison in the Chair. On roll call the following were found present. Alderman Wharton, Dean, Lee, McCay, Coleman and Gunnison. Mayor Allison. Absent Alderman Barton and Pratt. Minutes of the meeting of Aug. 13th were read and approved.

Mayor Allison Chairman of the Water Committee recommended that the time for receiving and opening bids for the City water works be extended until the second Tuesday in October at 12 o'clock M.

Alderman McCay moved that the report of the Water Committee be accepted, and the time extended as recommended until the second Tuesday in October at 12 o'clock noon, and all parties who have put in bids on the water works be notified of such extension and permitted to recollect their bids or put in new ones, and the Clerk shall also notify other interested parties; and the Engineer is instructed to modify the date of beginning and ending work in accordance with this resolution; and the Clerk was further instructed to continue the insertion of his advertisement for proposals in all publications in which the same had appeared together with a notice of extension of time.

It was also resolved that the time for completing the works be extended to nine months from the signing of the contract. Upon the motion being seconded by Alderman Wharton, it was adopted by the following vote: Alderman Wharton ^{yes}, Dean ^{yes}, Lee ^{yes}, McCay ^{yes}, Gunnison ^{yes}, Coleman ^{yes}, Mayor ^{yes}.

On motion of Alderman McCay Council adjourned until Wednesday evening September 11th 1895 at 7.30 P.M.
