

Grand Junction Colo. November 26th 1895

Council met pursuant to adjournment, at 7.30 P.M., Mayor Allison presiding. On roll call there were found to be present Aldermen Whurston, McCarry, Hall, Coleman, Dean and Pratt, and Mayor Allison absent. Aldermen Bustar and Gorman.

The following resolution was introduced and a motion of Alderman McCarry was unanimously adopted.

Resolved, That the city attorney be and he is hereby instructed and directed to at once commence the proper proceedings in the courts in the name of the city, to condemn and appropriate so much private property as may be necessary in the opening of Main street, and Spruce street and the alley running north and south through block 8, as the same are laid out and platted in the plat of Richard D. Mobley's First Sub-Division to the town of Grand Junction, Colorado, as recorded in the office of the clerk and recorder of Mesa county, Colorado.

On motion of Alderman Whurston the Committee on Streets and Alleys was instructed to examine the City hall and to provide for any necessary repairs.

On motion Council adjourned.
