

Grand Junction, Colo. December 12th 1895.

Council met pursuant to adjournment at 7.30 P.M.
Mayor Allison presiding. One Roll Call there were
found to be present Aldermen Winston, Deane, Lee
McCoy, Coleman and Gunnison and Mayor Allison.

Aldert Alderman Pratt and Burton, the minutes
of the meetings of Nov. 12th and 26th and Dec 10th were
read and approved. The reports of the City Treasurer
City Engineer, City Marshall, City Physician and
Police Magistrate were read and referred to the
Committee on Finance. The Committee on License
by Chairman McCoy ^{reported} recommended that no
action be taken on the open House petition and
the report was unanimously adopted.

The Street and Alley Committee reported
recommending that the petitions of Edmer
Rasmussen et al and Buelton, Roney et al.
be laid on the table and the report was adopted.

Alderman Coleman then introduced the following
resolution which was unanimously adopted.

Resolved, that hereafter no sidewalk shall be ordered
constructed of a less width than six feet at any
place within the district bounded by Hill Ave. on
the North, ~~the~~ ^{South} Ave. on the South, 10th Street on the
East and 1st Street on the West. The following

were allowed and the Clerk instructed to draw warrants
