

Grand Junction Co. July 14th - 1896 -

Council met in regular session at 7.30 P.M. Mayor Allison presiding. On roll call there were found to be present Aldermen Coleman, Pratt, Lee Cary, Lee, Gunshaw, Whitton, Barton and Dean and Mayor Allison. Absent, none. The minutes of the meetings of Dec 12th and 17th were read, corrected and approved.

The reports of the City Treasurer, City weigher, City Marshall, Police Magistrate and Fire Chief for the month of Dec. 1895, were read and referred to the Committee on Finance. On motion of Ald. Dean Sec. by Ald. Lee the Purchasing Committee was instructed to purchase a business sack for use in the fire department. The following bills were then read, and on motions were allowed and the Clerk was instructed to draw warrants for the same.

A bill of the Steer-Pines for 31⁸⁵ was referred to the Purchasing Committee. An ordinance entitled "An ordinance concerning bicycles, tricycles, velocipedes and other riding machines and vehicles" and numbered Fifty, which had been introduced at the meeting of October 4th 1895 was then called up by Alderman Pratt, read and placed on its passage and adopted by the following vote: Aldermen voting were Dean 4-4 Pratt 4-4 Coleman 4-4 Gunison 4-4 Barton 4-4 Whitton 4-4 Lee 4-4 Cary 4-4. An motion the matter of securing right of way for the Mountain Water pipe line across the State bridge to be erected at the Narrows was referred to a Committee composed of Ald.
