

Grand Junction Co. March 3^d 1896.

Council met pursuant to adjournment at 7.30 P.M., Mayor Allison presiding. On roll call there were found to be present Aldermen Wharton, Dean, McCary, Coleman and Cannon and Mayor Allison. Absent Aldermen - see last Boston. Minutes of the meeting of Feb'y 18th were read and adopted. A petition of W.D. Jones for a transfer of his saloon license to Russell and Henry was read and on motion granted. The report of the City Clerk for the fiscal year to date was audited and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Mayor Allison then addressed the Council regarding the expense of the mountain water project. An itemized statement of said expense was then read. P. U. Rice then addressed the Council. Alderman Coleman moved that a Committee of three be appointed by the Citizens for the purpose of investigating the records and accounts of the City for the past 8 or ten years, upon the motion being seconded by Alderman Dean it was unanimously adopted. Dr. Gould petitioned the Council for permission to construct a telephone line between his office and residence. On motion of Alderman Coleman sec. by Alderman Wharton the petition of Dr. Gould was granted.

Alderman McCary then made the following motion. I move that the polling places in the various wards for the ensuing election be designated as Turner Hall in the 1st ward, Brunswick except name in the 2nd ward, Remondt House in the 3^d ward, Wood The Horse house in the 4th ward. Upon the motion being seconded by Alderman Wharton it was unanimously adopted. Alderman Wharton then reads the following motion which was unanimously adopted. That the following named persons be selected as the judges of election in the various wards of the City for the ensuing election.

1st Ward, W. E. Huntington, W. C. Anderson, W. J. Russell
2nd Ward, W. U. Rice, Fred Bentley, W. G. Brown Sr
3^d Ward, W. G. Cannady, J. C. Crawford, W. A. Abbey
4th Ward, F. W. Welch, C. P. McFarland, G. W. Hancock

On motion of Alderman Coleman Council adjourned.
