

Grand Junction, Colorado, April 18th 1896

Council met pursuant to adjournment at 7.30 P.M. Mayor Adams presiding. One roll call there were found to be present Aldermen Wharton, Duce, Lee, McCary and Gunn, and Mayor Adams, Alder Alderman Bastine and Adams. The minutes of the meetings of March 11th and 15th, April 14th and 17th were read and adopted.

A petition of Alexander Grant for a license to run a "livery" was read and referred to the Committee on License. Reports of the City Treasurer, Mayor, Marshall and Police Magistrate for the month of March and the financial statements of the City Treasurer and City Clerk, were read and referred to the Committee on Finance.

The Committee on License reported recommending that the petition of Walter L. Adams be laid on the table. Ald. Wharton moved that the City Treasurer be instructed to accept the sum of \$50. as a license fee from Walter L.
