

Grand Junction Col., April 20, 1896.

Council met pursuant to adjournment at 7.30 P.M. Upon roll call there were found to be present Aldermen Whorton, Dean, Lee, M^c Carey Coleman, Gannon and Mayor Allison. Absent Alderman Barton.

Minutes of the meeting of April 18, were read and on motion were approved.

Bills - No 64 to B. F. Jay \$66 ⁵⁶/₁₀₀; No. 63, to J. L. Gray \$11.62. No. 62 to Western Union Telegraph Co. - \$2.95 - were read and on motion allowed and the clerk instructed to draw warrants for the same.

On motion the clerk was instructed to draw duplicate warrants for all enjoined warrants from the Deficiency fund.

On motion Council took a recess of five minutes, & during the intermission Aldermen M^c Carey, Dean & Gannon retired, and new Aldermen J. R. Fallis representing 1st ward, A. S. McKimney representing 2nd ward, A. R. Hadsworth representing 3rd ward and R. E. Starr representing 4th ward having taken the oath of office, took their seats as members of the Council.

Applications for the position of Night Policeman were then read from Lee H. Purnell & J. I. Allison ^(Alderman Starr) ~~for the position of Night Policeman~~ ^{on motion} the council proceeded to ballot for Night Policeman with the following result
