

May 23, 1896.

Council met pursuant to adjournment.

On roll call there was found to be present Aldermen Coleman, Fallis, Lee, Wadsworth, Starr and Whorton and Mayor Allison.

Absent Aldermen Baston and W. C. Kinney.

Mayor Allison read a memorandum of agreement between H. F. W. C. Cue and Frank H. Strong and Chas. P. Allen, in which H. F. W. C. Cue assigned his interest in the bid, as accepted by council in minutes of Oct. 9, 1896, to construct a system of water works for the City of Grand Junction, to Frank H. Strong and Chas. P. Allen.

The following resolution was read and on motion adopted by unanimous vote.

"Resolved that the assignment made by H. F. W. C. Cue to Frank H. Strong and Chas. P. Allen, of his interest in the contract to construct certain water works for the city of Grand Junction, be accepted."

The contract between Frank H. Strong and Charles P. Allen and the City of Grand Junction was read and discussed and the following resolution, on motion, adopted by unanimous vote. - - - - "Resolved that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign the contract, as read, between Frank H. Strong and Chas. P. Allen and the City of Grand Junction for the construction of the City Water Works."

The following resolution was read and on motion adopted. -

Resolved that Frank H. Strong and Chas. P. Allen shall execute a good and sufficient bond, in the sum of \$25,000⁰⁰ to the City of Grand Junction, conditioned for the faithful carrying out of the contract between them and the City of Grand Junction.

The bond of Frank H. Strong and Chas. P. Allen in the sum of \$25,000⁰⁰, with Frank H. Strong, Chas. P. Allen, D. H. Moffat, W. S. Cheeman and E. Monash as sureties, was read and on motion accepted.

On motion Council adjourned
