for extension of sidewalks, were read and  
referred to Street and Alley Committee.

Monthly reports of City Marshall, Police Magistrate,  
City Engineer, and City Treasurer were read and  
referred to Finance Committee.

Finance Committee reported on officers  
reports for May, which was on motion accepted.

Street and alley committee reported on petitions  
regarding St. Railway repairs and Express Licence.

St. Rail Way track, on 5<sup>th</sup> St. from Colorado  
Avenue South to end of the line, was on motion,  
ordered to be taken up and street left in good  
order. The matter was placed in charge of the  
City Marshall.

Alderman Coleman introduced the following resolution. "Whereas the Colorado Fuel and Iron Co. have assigned to C. P. Allen and F. H. Strong, all of its interest in and to a certain contract for the construction of city water works for the City of Grand Junction, now, therefore, be it resolved that the said assignment be hereby accepted."

Alderman Coleman introduced the following resolution. "Whereas, The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, did at a regular meeting, held on May 23, A. D. 1896 Pass a resolution, authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign on the part of said City a contract, with C. P. Allen and F. H. Strong, for Water Works for said City, and whereas, said parties have reported to the Council the signing of said contract, on their part, and it appears that the same has been duly entered and executed.

Therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, that the appointment of said parties to sign, and their signing said contract, is hereby ratified and the same fully accepted.

A motion to accept the above resolution was made by Alderman Whorton and seconded by Ald. McKinney
