September 8. 1896

Council met in regular session at 7:30 P. M.  
On roll call there were found to be present Aldermen  
Coleman, Fallis, Lee, W. Kinney, Wadsworth, Whorton & Starr  
Absent Aldermen Barton and  
Mayor Allison

In the absence of Mayor Allison and Chairman  
Barton, on motion Alderman Coleman was elected  
Chairman Pro. tem.

Minutes of the meetings of August 11, 18 and 29 were  
read and on motion approved.

A petition from property owners asking for sidewalk  
on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street between Curay and White Sts was read &  
referred to St. & Alley committee.

Reports <sup>for Aug</sup> of City Treasurer, City Weigher, City Marshall and Police Magistrates were submitted & referred to Finance Committee

Finance Com. reported, officers reports, for July to be correct.

St. & Alley com. reported & with the City Attorney submitted the following resolution: -

"Be it resolved, by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that a sidewalk be & is hereby ordered constructed within said City, commencing at a point on the South side of Main Street in front of lot 12 and running East to Eleventh St., thence South, on the east side of Eleventh St. to Colorado Avenue

That the said sidewalk shall be constructed in accordance with Ordinance No. 16, of the City of Grand Junction, excepting, that the same shall be 6 ft in width on Main St., the other 4 ft.

That the St. Commissioner be, & is hereby ordered to forthwith serve the proper notices upon the owners or agents, of each lot or parcel of land fronting upon such sidewalk."

No says none. Resolution adopted.
