

Grand Junction, Colo. Oct. 14, 1896.

Council met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock  
A.M. Mayor Allison presiding.

Present Aldermen, Coleman, Lee, W. McKinney, Madenworth,  
Whorton, Starr. Absent Alderman Barton and Fallis.

On Motion of Alderman Lee, the Council went into  
Executive Session.

After discussion of the Water question and consulting  
one of the Attorneys for the City. On motion of Alderman  
W. McKinney the following resolution was adopted:

Vote. Yes. - Alderman Coleman, Lee, W. McKinney, Madenworth,  
Whorton, Starr. No. - none.

The following resolution: -

BE IT RESOLVED - That the committee  
appointed at the request of the Water  
Co. to entertain a proposition of Water  
Co. for the purchase of the water plant,  
having received said proposition from  
Water Co. and said proposition being  
for the sum of \$100,000 which is con-  
sidered by the committee and council  
to be a sum far in excess of the value  
of the plant. It appears that it is use-  
less to further consider the matter,  
therefore the committee is hereby dis-  
charged.

The following resolution to order sidewalk  
in front of Chipman + Roland Block was adopted  
by the following vote, yes, Alderman Coleman,  
Lee, W. McKinney, Madenworth, Whorton, Starr,  
Absent Alderman Barton + Fallis, no none

Be it resolved, that a sidewalk 12 ft. in width be and is  
hereby ordered to be put down, under the supervision of  
the Street Commissioner, on Main Street, in front of the  
Chipman and Doland Blocks.
