

Grand Junction Colo. Nov. 10. 1896.

Council met in regular session at 7:30 P.M. In the absence of Mayor Allison, Alderman Coleman was elected Chairman.

Present aldermen Coleman, Kalle, Lee, Madeworth, Whorton and Starr. Absent Aldermen Bertoni and W.C. Kinney and Mayor Allison.

The minutes of Oct. 13 and 14 were read and approved. The petition from Cadet Band was taken from the table and on motion, granted on condition of good behavior and provided their meetings do not conflict with the Firemen's meetings.

Monthly reports for October, of City Treasurer, City Wigher, Police Magistrate and City Marshall, were submitted and referred to Finance Committee.

Finance Committee reported that the September reports of City Treasurer, City Wigher & Police Magistrate were correct but asked to hold the City Marshall's report until next meeting.

The Question of side-walk on the East side of 2nd Street, between Osray and White Streets, was on motion referred to Street and Alley Committee, to report at the next meeting.
