

Grand Junction Col. Nov. 17, '96

City Council met pursuant to adjournment at 7:30 P. M. <sup>(21)</sup> In the absence of Mayor Allison, Alderman Wadsworth was elected chairman.

"On roll call there were found to be present, Aldermen: Coleman, Fallis, Lee, M<sup>c</sup>Kinney, Wadsworth, Whorton and Starr, Absent, Alderman Barton & Mayor Allison.

The following resolution was adopted:

"Be it resolved by the City Council, of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

That a sidewalk be constructed on the East side of Second Street, between Ouray and White Streets, of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado."

patch the building for \$40, was accepted, the work to be done under the supervision of the Purchasing Committee.

On motion the matter of purchasing new hose was referred to the Fire and Police Committee with instructions to report at the next <sup>regular</sup> meeting.

On motion the Street and Alley Committee were instructed to confer with the R. Grand Western and ask them to construct a crossing where their road intersects Main Street.

Moved that the Fire Committee be instructed to investigate the matter of Mr. Shields, with power to act.  
Carried.

On motion, that the renting, of the City Hall cellar, was left with the Janitor.
