

Grand Junction Colo. Feb. 10. 1877.

Council met pursuant to adjournment at 7:30 P.M. Mayor Allison Presiding

On roll call there were found to be present Aldermen Coleman, Fells, Lee, Wadsworth and Starr.

Absent Aldermen Barton, Mr. Kinney and Whorton. Minutes of Jan. 12 were read and approved.

A petition in regard to licence was read and on motion, referred to City Attorney to investigate whether an ordinance exists, which covers the petition and if not, to draft one, to be acted upon later.

A petition to open Colorado Ave. read and on motion it was left to the City Attorney and the St. & C. Committee to investigate the matter, make an agreement with Mr. Buser as to price of land, and <sup>the attorney</sup> prepare an ordinance ordering the street opened.

A petition for sidewalk on Reed St. between Second & Third Sts. read and <sup>on 1/10/77</sup> referred to St. & C. Committee

A petition for permission to erect a post, on which

to suspend a sign, was read and referred to St & A. Committee by the following vote. Aldermen Falls <sup>yea</sup> Lect. <sup>yea</sup> & Madewell <sup>yea</sup>. Aldermen Coleman <sup>may</sup> & Starr <sup>may</sup>.

Finance Com. reported the Officers reports for Dec. '96 to be correct.

A reply, to the resolution passed Jan. 12, from the Grand Junction Water Co. was read and on motion the marshall was instructed to notify the Water Co. requesting them to meet with the Council. in the Council Room Feb. 11. at 2 o'clock P.M.
