

Grand Junction Col. Feb. 9 '97

The City Council met in regular session at 7:30 P.M. Mayor Allison presiding. On roll call there were found to be present Aldermen Coleman, Fallis, Lee, W.C. Kinney, Wadsworth, Whorton and Starr. Absent none.

Minutes of the meetings of Feb. 9, 10, 11, 18, 19, 20 and March 5 were read and after correction were on motion approved.

On motion the rules were suspended, the regular business was postponed and special business was taken up.

The petition for a Sewer System was taken from the table and read. The City Attorney was instructed to more fully investigate the matter and report at the next meeting.

Ordinance No. 54. Entitled was taken from the table and read and placed on its passage and adopted by the following vote: -

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE the City of Grand Junction to purchase the waterworks, rights, privileges and property of the Grand Junction Water Company, and to submit to all taxpayers under the law of said city the question of the authorization of such purchase.

An ordinance No. 55. Entitled was presented and read. The rules were suspended by the following vote:

Ordinance No. 55.  
AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE the City Council of the City of Grand Junction to purchase, and improve and repair the water works plant and system now in operation in said city; and in the event of a failure to purchase the same, to construct a system of water works for fire protection and domestic purposes, to be forever owned, managed and operated by said city; and to contract an indebtedness on behalf of said city, by the issuance of its bonds to the sum of \$55,000.00, for such purpose; and to submit the question of such approval and authorization to the voters of the city who are taxpayers under the law.

The ordinance was at once placed on its passage and adopted by the following vote. Aldermen <sup>voting</sup> Coleman, yea, Fallis, yea, Lee, yea, W.C. Kinney, yea, Wadsworth, yea, Whorton, yea and Starr, yea.

An agreement between Mr. Bieser and the City of Grand Junction, was presented and on motion of Alderman Wadsworth was accepted.

Roll Call. Aldermen voting. Coleman yea, Fallis yea, Lee yea, W.C. Kinney, yea, Wadsworth, yea, Whorton, yea, Starr, yea.

On motion the Mayor and Clerk were instructed to sign the agreement.

A petition concerning the filling of the streets with gravel or crushed stone instead of dirt was submitted and on motion was referred to the Street & Alley committee.
