

Grand Junction, Colo. Mich 20, 1897

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment at 10 o'clock A. M. Mayor Allison presiding. Aldermen present: Coleman, Lee, Madeworth, Whorton and Starr

Ordinance No. 57, entitled "Appropriation ordinance" was introduced. On motion the rules were suspended by the following vote: - Aldermen voting: - Coleman, yea, Lee, yea, Madeworth, yea, Whorton, yea, Starr, yea. The ordinance was at once placed on its passage and on motion adopted by the following vote: - Aldermen voting: - Coleman, yea, Lee, yea, Madeworth, yea, Whorton, yea, Starr, yea.

Alderman Whorton offered the following resolution

Resolved by the city council of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado, that the city attorney commence condemnation proceedings at once against the Denver and B'n Grande R. R. company for the purpose of opening up a street 60 feet in width, to connect Colorado avenue with Riverview avenue, said street to be located along the east side of lots 1 and 2, block 10, Mobley addition, to connect with Riverview and Lawrence avenues at the corner of Crawford addition."

A motion of Alderman Whorton to adopt was amended by Alderman Madeworth to refer to St. & A. Com. and carried.

The report of committee appointed to make an investigation of the Grand Junction Water plant, as to its value etc. was submitted. On motion the report was accepted and the committee discharged. On motion Council adjourned.
