The City Council met in regular session at 7:30 P.M. Mayor Allison presiding. On roll call there were found to be present Aldermen, Coleman, Lee, Starr, Wadsworth and Whorton. Absent Ald. Falls and W. Kinney.

An ordinance No. (58) was introduced by Alderman Whorton, Entitled "An ordinance to contract an indebtedness, on behalf of the City, by the issue of its bonds in the sum of \$65,000. to raise money for the purchase, improvement & repair of the water works plant and system now in operation in said City, or to construct a system of water works for fire, domestic and other purposes to be forever owned, managed and operated by the said City, and to carry out the provisions of ordinance No. 55."
