

Grand Junction, Colo. June. 22. 1897.

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment at 8 o'clock P.M. Chairman Wade with presiding. Aldermen present: - Hadcock, Starr, Wells, Meyer, and Whorton.

The St. and A. Committee recommended that the Street Commissioner divide the water of the Farmer's Ditch and thus make it less dangerous. On motion the matter was left with the St. and A. committee and the St. Commissioner to arrange as best they can.

The question of a Dumping ground was discussed. On motion the committee was continued with instructions to report at the next meeting.

Ordinance No. 61. was called up but on motion was left until the next meeting.

A committee from the Fire Co. petitioned the Council for an appropriation of \$100. to conduct a Firemen's Tournament during Beach week.

The Beach Day Committee, appeared before the council and after a discussion as to what the City would appropriate for Beach week expenses the Council took a recess of twenty minutes.

The council was again called to order.

A motion of Alderman Meyer. That the City give, to the Fire Co. \$500. and to the Beach Day Committee \$700. to be paid out of the \$1500. coming to the City from the State. was amended by Alderman Wells, that \$300 be given to the Fire Co. and \$700 to the Beach Day committee, provided that the County give \$250. and that the Committee raise \$100. on the outside. Carried.

On motion the City Attorney and the St. Commissioner were instructed to investigate concerning the ditches in the North Addition.

It was moved and seconded that a committee, of three, be appointed, by the Chair to look up the propriety of compiling our City ordinances and to make an estimate as to the expense. The committee appointed, were Aldermen, Starr, Wells and Meyer.

On Motion Council adjourned to meet July 6. at 8 o'clock P.M.
