

Grand Junction, Colo. July, 29, 1897

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment at 8 o'clock P. M. ^{Pres. Wagner presiding} Present Aldermen; - Hadcock, Starr, Heller, Meyer and Whorton. - Absent. Mayor Cla and Ald. - Fallis and W. C. Kinney

The Fire & Police Com. reported on Petition of F. M. Gordon & recommended that the Petition be granted. On motion the report was accepted.

A communication regarding the license for a Merry Go Round, to run during Beach Week, was read & the matter referred to the License Com.

The resignation of W. A. Amstutz as City Attorney was tendered and on motion accepted.

The following resolution was presented and adopted. ~~The roll was~~

"Whereas, by the resignation of W. A. Amstutz, the office of City Attorney of Grand Junction, has become vacant; therefore, - Be it resolved by the City Council that, J. S. Carnahan be and he is hereby selected and appointed to fill the unexpired term of the said W. A. Amstutz."

The roll was called on the above resolution, as follows. Aldermen voting. - Hadcock, yea; Starr, yea, Meyer, yea; and Whorton, yea. Heller yea.

A communication from the Western Slope Congress was read and referred to the Finance Com.

On motion the Clerk was instructed to deliver to W. Strouse, City warrants^{No.} 1775, 1776 & 1777. from St. & A. warrant book.

On motion the Fire Company were granted \$50. for training expenses of the running team.

An ordinance No. 63. Entitled "An ordinance to amend subdivision 11 of section 1 of an ordinance entitled 'An ordinance concerning licenses.'" was read & laid over until the next meeting.

On motion it was ordered that notices be served upon the proper parties, that the St. Car track on First Street be completed & the street put in proper condition or the track taken up, within thirty days.

The Janitor asked for 100 feet of 1 inch hose, for use around the City Hall. The matter was left with the Fire & Police Committee.

On motion Council adjourned.
