

Grand Junction, Colo. Sept. 1. 1899.

Council met pursuant to adjournment at
8:00 P. M. On roll call the following responded. -
Aldermen: - Fallis, Hadcock, McKinney, Starr, Wells, and
Weyer, Absent Mayor Ela, Chairman Hadeworth and
Alderman Whorton. Alderman Wells was appointed
Chairman.

Minutes of Aug. 26. and Aug. 30. were read and
approved.

A motion was made to grant the petition of
Mrs. H. P. Carpenter, to build a hotel on the corner of

1st and 5th streets, according to the plans & specifications as presented to the Council.

The roll was called on the above motion, resulting as follows: Aldermen voting: - Fallis, yea; Hadcock, yea; McKinney, nay; Starr, yea; Wells, yea; Meyer, nay; The motion carried.

A motion, ^{was made} that Mrs. Carpenter be required to sign a contract, to build this building according to the specifications, given by Mr. Marsh, and that the Street & Alley committee be empowered to inspect the building during its erection and at any time that the contract is violated, to stop the work at once. Carried.

Mr. Starr moved the adoption of the following resolution: -

"Whereas, Mayor H. P. Ela is absent from the City of Grand Junction, and whereas the Mayor Pro Tem, Mr. A. R. Hadsoworth is confined to his home by serious sickness and is unable to attend and preside at the meetings of the City Council, or to perform the duties of the office.

Therefore be it resolved by the City Council that Mr. A. R. Wells, be and he hereby is elected to preside as Mayor Pro Tem during the absence of Mr. A. R. Hadsoworth, and empowered to perform all the duties of said office during the aforesaid disabilities."

The roll was called on the above resolution as follows: - Aldermen voting: - Fallis, yea; Hadcock, yea; McKinney, yea; Starr, yea; Meyer, yea;

On motion Council adjourned.
