

Oct. 29. 1897.

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment at 8 o'clock P.M. Mayor Cla presiding. Aldermen present. - Fallis, Hadcock, W. McKinney, Starr, Wells, Meyer and Whorton. Absent. Ald. Madenworth.

The minutes of Oct. 19th were read and approved.

A petition from James Purcell to build a frame dwelling on Bond Street between 2nd + 3^d St. was submitted and on motion was granted. The roll was called resulting as follows: Fallis, yea; Hadcock, yea; W. McKinney, yea; Starr, yea; Wells, yea; Meyer, yea; Whorton, nay.

A Petition for a sidewalk on Grand Avenue was submitted and on motion was referred to the St. & A. committee. The committee asked to report at once. permission was given them & they recommended that the petition be granted.

On motion the petition was granted.

The City Attorney reported on the bill of Mr. Lecher's
 suit: that after a careful investigation, he could
 learn of no injuries received, as a result of the
 accident & advised that the bill be not allowed.

On motion the bill was disallowed.

 to rule, was laid over until the next meeting.

 so as to dispense with the City Teamster, was
 left with the Street & Alley Com. & they to make
 report at the next meeting.
