The City Council met pursuant to adjournment. - Mayor Cla presiding; - Aldermen present Hallie Hadcock, Starr, Wadsworth, Wells, Meyer and Whorton. Aldermen absent; - W. C. Kinney.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. -

The license committee reported relative to the license on Merry go Round during the winter months, and recommended a license of \$5.00 per month be charged. On motion the license was made ^{\$4 per mo.} 3.00 for five months.

Alderman Hadcock reported favorably on the petition of Mr. Crosby. after discussion, on motion the matter was laid over until next meeting.

On motion the business, relative to the opening of streets across the R. R. tracks into Crawford Addition, was laid over until the next meeting.

Mr. Johnson presented the matter of the Damage Claims of Mr. Lesher. On motion it was agreed that Articles of Arbitration between Mr. Lesher and the City of Grand Junction be drawn up, the board of arbitrators to be Mr. Ela, Mr. Johnson and a member of the Council to be appointed by the Mayor.

A bill ^{No. 427} of James Green for \$4.00 was allowed. + the clerk instructed to draw a warrant for the same.

On motion of Alderman Starr, \$100. was transferred from the General Fund to the St. & A. Fund.

A bill No. 426. to Dr. Eldridge, for \$34. was allowed and the clerk, instructed to draw a warrant for same.

On motion the City Attorney was instructed to confer with the Attorney for the Water Co. and make arrangements to advance, if possible, the Hydrant Rental Case, in Court of Appeals.
