

Grand Junction Colo. Nov. 24, 1897.

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment
Mayor Ela presiding. Aldermen present: - Fells,
Horton, Wells, Meyer, Starr and Hadcock. Absent
McKinney and Wadsworth.

The Crook Gas Ordinance No. - was
submitted by Alderman Hadcock and read.

On motion of Alderman Wells, a committee
of three was appointed to confer with the City
Attorney and draft an ordinance for Gas
Franchise. The Mayor appointed ~~the~~ the same
committee, appointed Nov. 11. to wit: Aldermen
Hadcock, Wadsworth and Starr.

A petition from Mrs. Hatcher, et al. - relative to
closing of places of amusement on Sunday,
was read and referred to Fire & Police Committee.

On motion of Alderman Starr the Marshal
was instructed to notify the proprietors of all saloons
in the city, to furnish a Bond as required by
the ordinance.

Nov. 30 at 7:30 P.M.
