

Grand Junction Co. Nov. 30, 1877.  
 The City Council met pursuant to adjournment,  
 Mayor Eld presiding, on roll being called the following  
 Aldermen were found to be present: - Fellis, Starr,  
 Wells, Meyer, Whorton and W. C. Kinney. Absent:  
 Haddock and Hadenorth.

Reading of the minutes of previous meetings  
 Petitions for Retail Liquor License and Bonds  
 for the same were filed by: - Rainet Kane,  
 Russell & Hughes, & J. E. Dalmaine, and each  
 and all were referred to the License Com.,  
 for consideration.

An Ordinance, Granting to David R. Coakly,  
 a franchise for Gas plant was then introduced  
 by the Chairman of the Committee, heretofore  
 appointed on this subject, and the same  
 was explained and considered and again  
 referred to the committee.

A communication was received and  
 read from R. H. Constan, relative to the  
 purchasing of second hand <sup>fire</sup> hose, and same  
 was referred to the Committee on Fire and  
 Police with power in that Committee to act  
 in the matter.

A communication from Platt Rogers, to  
 City Attorney was read, relative to Counsel  
 in the Water case, now noticed for trial.

It was moved that Mr. Rogers be retained  
 by the City at \$10. retainer fee and \$30. per  
 day and expenses, for the trial of this cause.

On motion being put the following vote was  
 taken: Aldermen voting: - W. C. Kinney, yea;  
 Whorton, yea; Meyer, yea; Fellis, nay; Starr, nay;  
 Wells, nay. The Mayor voting nay. The motion  
 was lost.

It was then moved that the City Attorney be  
 empowered to get such assistance as he deems  
 necessary for the trial of this cause and at such  
 reasonable fee as he may arrange, and on  
 motion being put the following vote was  
 taken thereon. Aldermen voting: Fellis, yea;  
 Starr, yea; Wells, yea; Whorton, yea; W. C. Kinney, yea;  
 and Meyer yea. The Motion Carried.

On motion Council adjourned until  
 Friday Dec. 3, 1877 at 7:30 P.M.
