

Grand Junction, Colo. January. 11., 1898

The City Council met in regular session at 7:30 P.M. Mayor Cla presiding, and the following aldermen present: - Fallis, Hadcock, McKinney, Starr, Wadsworth, Wells, Meyer and Whorton.

The minutes of the meetings of Dec. 14, 15 and on motion were approved.

Minutes of the meeting held Dec. 21 were read. Alderman Wadsworth objected to the resolution adopted at this meeting, relative to the discharge of the Water Committee and made a motion that said resolution be stricken out of the minutes. On motion being put the roll was called, resulting as follows: Ald voting: Fallis nay, Hadcock nay, Starr, nay, McKinney nay, Wadsworth, yea; Wells, nay; Meyer, yea; Whorton, yea. The motion was lost.

A motion was made to adopt the minutes of Dec. 21. On motion being put the vote was as follows: Ald voting: - Fallis, yea; Hadcock, yea; McKinney, yea; Starr, yea; Wadsworth, nay; Wells, yea; Meyer, nay; Whorton, nay. The motion carried and the minutes were approved.

The minutes of Dec. 28 were read and on motion approved.

On motion the council adjourned to the City Hall.

A petition, from M. W. <sup>you presented</sup> Shores, asking permission to erect a <sup>you presented</sup> roof, over the yard in the rear of his place of business on Main St, to cover farm implement etc. - On motion the petition was granted.

The reports of officers for Dec. - were submitted and referred to the Finance Com.

The finance committee reported that they had examined the officers reports for November & found them to be correct. On motion the report was accepted.

The License Com. reported on the Ord. on Saloon License & Screens and Restaurants and recommended that Sec. 1 be stricken out.

On motion to accept the report the following vote was taken. Ald. voting: Fallis, nay; Hadcock, nay; McKinney, yea; Starr, yea; Wadsworth, nay; Wells, nay; Meyer, yea; Whorton, yea; There being a tie in the vote. The Mayor's name was called & he cast his vote in the negative & the motion was lost.

A communication, of C. H. Johnson, relative to the transfer of the License for Saloon, heretofore granted permission, to Lecher & Murray, to be made to the Grand Jct Lignor Co.

Ald. Wadsworth moved the adoption of the following resolution: - "Be it resolved that permission be granted to Wm B. Lecher and Paul C. Murray to assign the Lignor License heretofore granted to them to the Grand Junction Lignor Co."

Be it further resolved, that this committee shall transact and complete the business and work as set forth in the original resolution, authorizing said special committee, before it shall be discharged and.

Be it further resolved, that the Mayor is hereby instructed to turn over all communications in his possession that will in any way aid this committee in the discharge of its official duties;
