

Grand Junction, Colo. Feb. 8, 1878.

The City Council met in regular session at 7:30 P.M. Mayor Ela presiding. Aldermen present: - Fallis, Hadcock, W. Kinney, Starr, Hadsworth, Meyer and Thornton. Absent, Wells and W. Kinney.

Minutes of Jan. 18, 20, 22, 26 & Feb. 2 were read and approved.

A petition to appoint S. Logan as Special Police man for the R.R. Yards. and a bond for the same were read and on motion were referred to the Com. on Fire & Police.

The reports of officers for the month of January were submitted and referred to Finance Com.

Ald. Starr reported on License Ordinance and recommended its adoption by sections Finance Com. were not ready to report on Officers reports for Dec.

The St. & A. Com. were not ready to report on lots for City Pound but suggested that the Council advertise for prices on lots. Ald. Meyer moved that an advertisement be inserted in the papers for prices on lots for a City Pound.

The Fire & Police Com. recommended that the sum of \$30.00 be paid to the Fire Co. and on motion the Clerk was instructed to draw a warrant for that amount from Fire Fund. - -

A bill to Rogers & Shapoth, of Denver, for \$15.50 cash was read and on motion allowed and the Clerk instructed to draw a warrant for the same.

On motion the consideration of Ordinances was laid over until next meeting.

The Bond of J. T. Hartman, in the sum of \$2000, for a Saloon License, was read. A motion was made to accept. The roll was called, resulting as follows: - Fallis, yea; Hadcock, nay; Starr, yea; Wadsworth, yea; Weyer yea; Whorton, yea. Motion Carried.

On motion the City Attorney was instructed to secure such legal assistance as he deems necessary, in the Hydrant Rental Case, now pending in the District Court.

A motion was made that Mr. Carnahan be instructed to send the samples of Water, to Prof. J. A. Sewell, of Denver, for analysis, and that the expense of \$250, be incurred. The roll was called on the above motion, resulting as follows: Ald. voting; Fallis yea; Hadcock, yea; Starr, yea; Wadsworth, yea; Weyer, yea; Whorton yea. Motion Carried.

A motion was made that a committee be appointed to confer with C. V. Shores and ascertain what arrangements may be made toward opening Main St. The motion carried and the following committee was appointed: Aldermen: Weyer, Whorton and Starr.

Ordinance No. 70^{re-entitled} was introduced and referred to Police Com.

On motion Council adjourned until Wednesday^{Feb. 9} at 7:30 P. M.
