

Grand Junction Colo. Feb. 9th 98

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment at 7:30 P. M. Mayor Cla presiding. Aldermen present; Fallis, Hadcock, Starr, Wadsworth, Meyer, Whorton. Absent: M. Kimney and Wells.

In absence of the Clerk, City Attorney Carnahan, was appointed Clerk Pro Tem.

The Fire & Police Committee reported on Ord. No. 70. An ord. concerning Bandy Houses, and recommended that it be considered by the Council. On motion the report was accepted.

On motion to adopt Ordinance No. 70, Entitled "An Ordinance concerning Bandy Houses": The roll was called resulting the follows. Ald. voting: - Fallis, yea; Hadcock, nay; Starr, nay; Wadsworth, yea; Meyer, yea; Whorton, yea.

The motion failed to carry.

On motion Ordinance No. 69, Entitled "An ordinance concerning licenses and repealing Sec. 1. of Ordinance No. 8. passed and adopted Sep. 26 1891. Also repealing Ordinance No. 25 - passed and adopted Sep. 26. 1891. Also repealing Ordinance No. 47. passed July 9. 1896; Also Ordinance No. 63. passed Aug. 12. 1897." was taken up, and considered by sections.

The license for foot-peddlers was fixed at \$1.00 Per day.
License for peddlers with one horse wagon. \$2.50 per day.

On motion Ordinance No. 69, was placed on its passage and adopted by the following vote: Ald. voting: Fallis yea; Hadcock, yea; Starr, yea; Wadsworth, yea; Meyer, yea; Whorton, yea. Ord. No. 69 was declared passed and adopted.
