

Grand Junction, Colo. March 2, 1898.

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment Mayor De Presiding. On roll call the following aldermen responded: - Fallis, Hadcock, McKinney, Starr, Helle, and Whorton.

Aldermen absent: - Wadeworth and Meyer. Minutes of the meeting held Feb. 28 were read.

Alderman Fallis introduced an Ordinance, numbered (70). An ordinance entitled: - "An ordinance to contract an indebtedness on behalf of the City of Grand Junction, by the issue of its bonds in the sum of fifty-five thousand dollars, for the purchase of the Grand Junction Water Company's plant and system of water-works, now in operation in said city, the same to be forever owned, managed, and operated by the said City for the purpose of supplying the City and the inhabitants thereof with water for fire and domestic purposes".

The ordinance was read. It was moved and seconded that it be referred to the Purchasing Committee.

On motion being put, the vote was taken as follows: - Aldermen voting: - Fallis, yea; Hadcock, yea; McKinney, yea; Helle, yea; Whorton, nay; Starr, yea.

The motion carried and the ordinance was referred to the Purchasing Com.

On motion Council adjourned.
