

Grand Junction Col. April 18, 1898.

Minutes of April 12
were read and
approved.

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment
at 8:00 o'clock P. M. On roll call the following
responded: Mayor Cla, Aldermen, Fallis, Hadcock,
McKinney, Starr, Wadsworth, Wells, Meyer & Whorton.

The St. & Alley Committee reported the bill of
J. J. Lumsden, ^{No. 47} to be correct.
On motion the bill was allowed and the clerk
instructed to draw a warrant for the same.

The Finance Com. reported that Officers reports
for the Month of March were correct.
also that they had been unable to investigate relative
to the bill of the County Treasurer. also reported on
the bill of Sentinel.

On motion the report of the Committee was
accepted.

On motion the bill of The Sentinel, ^{No. 45} for \$110.⁰⁰
was allowed, & the clerk instructed to draw a
warrant for the same. The roll was called
on this motion resulting as follows: - Ald. voting: -

Fallis, yea; Hadcock, yea; McKinney, yea; Starr, yea;
Wadsworth, yea; Wells, yea; Meyer, yea; Whorton, yea. Carried

On motion the clerk was allowed more time on her
report.

The Deed of Mr. Beeser conveying to the City the
land, as per agreement, filed. was presented
by City Attorney. On motion was made & seconded
to accept the Deed and that the clerk draw a warrant
for the cash value of \$300.⁰⁰.

The roll was called on
this motion, resulting as follows: Ald. voting: - Fallis, yea;
Hadcock, yea; McKinney, yea; Starr, yea; Wadsworth, yea;
Wells, yea; Meyer, yea; Whorton, yea. Motion was
declared carried.

The Deed from Mr. L. A. Whitehead conveying to
the City Lots 1, 2, 3, & 4, Block 68, for use as a City Pound,
for the sum of \$275.⁰⁰, was presented.

A motion was made to accept the deed and
that Clerk be instructed to draw a warrant for \$275.⁰⁰

The roll was called as follows: - Ald. voting: - Fallis, yea;
Hadcock, yea; McKinney, yea; Starr, yea; Wadsworth, yea;
Wells, nay; Meyer, yea; Whorton, nay. Motion Carried.

The bill of Lee H. Purnell, No. 44 for \$8.⁰⁰ and a
bill of J. S. Carnahan No. 46 for 10.⁰⁰ were read and
on motion allowed and the clerk instructed to draw
warrants for the same.

The roll was called on
this motion as follows: - Fallis, yea; McKinney, yea; Hadcock, yea;
Starr, yea; Wadsworth, yea; Wells, yea; Meyer, yea; Whorton, yea.

The bond of C. M. White in the sum of \$500.⁰⁰
with C. M. White and M. Strouse as signers was read.

On motion to accept the bond the roll was
called, resulting as follows. Ald. voting: - Fallis, yea;

Hadcock, nay; McKinney, nay; Starr, not voting; Hadenworth, yea;
Wells, yea; Meyer, yea; Whorton, yea.

The bond was accepted.

Ald. McKinney moved that St. Commissioners be instructed to assist Mr. White in getting the water running in the ditches, throughout the City, as soon as possible, and to hire such help as is necessary.

The motion was seconded.

Alderman Hadcock moved as an amendment to that motion that the action of the Council, at the last meeting, granting the contract to Mr. White be reconsidered.

The roll was called on the amended motion as follows. Ald. voting: - Fallis, yea; Hadcock, yea; McKinney, yea; Starr, nay; Hadenworth, nay; Wells, nay; Meyer, nay; Whorton, nay.

The roll was then called on the original motion, which resulted as follows: - Ald. voting. Fallis, yea; Hadcock, yea; McKinney, yea; Starr, yea; Hadenworth, yea; Wells, yea; Meyer, yea; Whorton, yea.

The motion carried.

On motion Council adjourned.
