

Grand Junction Colo April 26th 1898

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment at 8 o'clock P.M. on Roll call the following responded Mayor E.A. Alderman Wharton, Dickerson, Weyer, McKimney, Ramey, Starr and Haddock. Minutes of Apr 18 were read and approved.
