

Graud Junction May 2<sup>nd</sup> 1898

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment at 8 P.M. with Alderman Jas. H. Ranney, Pres. in chair. Our Roll call the following responded. Alderman Whorton Dickerson, Weyer, M. McKinney, Ranney, Headcock & Starr. Minutes of April 26<sup>th</sup> were read and approved. A petition was read asking Council to erect an arch light at the corner of Road & 8<sup>th</sup> Streets signed by Chas. A. Smith and 26 others. On motion by Alderman Starr same was referred to the Water & Light Com. & City Atty. Barnahan made a verbal report on Bills of B. J. Snyder & J. P. Sharp & recommended same be laid over. On motion by Ald. Headcock the Labor Bills were laid over. Working settlements of water Cases. On motion by Alderman Whorton Report of Street & Alley Com. and petition for side walk in front of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 also Lots 15 & 16 in Block 123 was accepted. On motion by Starr Marshall was instructed to notify owners of lots to lay sidewalk. Vote and same was as follows: Whorton, Dickerson, Weyer, McKinney, Ranney, Headcock & Starr voting yea. Same carried. On motion by Alderman Starr the Marshall was instructed to notify Lots owners along north side of Block 75 to lay sidewalk between 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Streets on our way ave. Vote and same was as follows. Whorton, Dickerson, Weyer, McKinney, Ranney, Headcock & Starr voting yea. On motion by Alderman Headcock action on water ordinance was deferred to our next meeting. Alderman McKinney made motion to change ordinance # to amend Sub Div # 14 of Sec 1 of ordinance # 69 passed 7/9<sup>th</sup> 1898. Same was referred to License Com. Finance Com. reported favorable on the Bonds of A. G. Mahan as Night Marshall. Geo. Gates Street Com. & F. Eldridge City Phys. & S. R. Vails City Treasure. On motion Coms report was accepted. On motion Bonds were accepted.

The following Bills were read. and on motion an Warrant was ordered drawn for same

Alderman Starr introduced ordinance # to amend ordinance 52 entitled an ordinance concerning poles passed & adopted April 28<sup>th</sup> 1896 that ordinance # 52 be and the same is hereby amended. on motion by Alderman McKinney same was referred to S & A Com. Alderman Headcock made motion that Marshall be instructed all owners of awnings to remove all Guy ropes on awnings so same would be in the clear of all footmen carried. On motion by Alderman Whorton Council proceed to elect Counselman to fill vacancy of Ald. Wells carried. on Mot. by Whorton proceed to vote 1<sup>st</sup> Ballot informal.
